Writer and photographer Roland Hagenberg grew up in Vienna, Austria. He currently lives in Tokyo. During the 80s he published art books in New York and documented the world of artists such as Andy Warhol, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Karel Appel and Keith Haring.

Hagenberg's stories and photographs are published in magazines such as Vogue and Architectural Digest. His book: 14 Japanese Contemporary Architects featuring Tadao Ando, Yoshio Taniguchi, Kazuyo Sejima and Arata Isozaki among others was recently released on DVD. Current projects include a series of short films for BMW's homepage and a video documentary on American star-photographer Sheila Metzner, for which Roland also wrote the music (his CD "Galaxy" is now available on iTunes).

In his new photographs exhibited at Sin Sin's Atelier and Annex - Hagenberg interprets Sin Sin's new collection "Rejuvenate!" with playful contrasts and shadows. Most of the black and white images were captured in Bali. The portraits of Lousia Chan wearing Sin Sin's designs originated in Hong Kong.
